<u>Cheyenne Ninja Warrior – Friday, February 23rd, 2018</u>



GET READY - GO TIME IS AROUND THE CORNER

Get the kids excited for this EPIC event! We have taken over the Arizona inflatable world with a total 21 obstacle experiences in combination with 10 awesome bodyweight challenges. That has to get your blood moving!

The top finishing teams will compete on a championship course designed by Mesa Firefighters ending with a vertical climb (harnessed) to the top of an inflatable rock wall. Winners of each grade will be crowned Cheyenne Ninja Warrior Champion receiving the coveted Warrior Bib.

CNW will be held at Chaparral Park with Ninja Arrival opening at 3:00 pm. Arrive Early to enjoy the festivities (*Truck Alley, Vendor Park, Bounce House, DJ, Food Trucks & Drinks*)

- Parking Map: See the attached even parking map that represents the 3 traffic patterns based on grade level. We kindly ask you do your best to adhere to this traffic pattern to ensure safe and efficient access for all.
- Shuttle: There will be (3) shuttles continually running between Mohave Middle School (MMS) and Chaparral Park. You can still drop people, strollers, etc. off at the park and then 1 parent/guardian uses the shuttle. Mohave Middle School is approximately 4 blocks from Chaparral Park, an estimated 1-2 min shuttle ride or a 10 min walk.
- Drink Tickets: Drink tickets will be available for purchase before and after school the week of the event and at the MMS Shuttle location. NO Drink Tickets will be sold at the Chaparral Park.
- Kids Drop: For parents that require the need to drop off and park we have created a Ninja Drop zone. This is shown on the attached Event Parking Map and available to all age groups.
- Entering the Event: Upon arriving please proceed directly to registration. After you have checked in you may enjoy the main area festivities; Truck Alley, Vendor Park, BBQ, Bounce House, DJ and the Drink Area. NO glass and/or NO outside food/drink allowed at the park or on the field per the City of Scottsdale. At NO time prior to the event start is anyone allowed on the field/course areas. Please help us ensure we are invited back next year and respect these requests.
- What to Wear: Be comfortable and wear athletic attire. Shoes will need to be removed when on the preliminary courses. There will be a collection area and the racers can return to their start position upon completion to recover their shoes. We recommend Ninjas wear socks and or with a rubber sole (i.e. Trampoline park socks). No Bare feet will be permitted. Have fun with your outfits, especially if Squads what to come dressed in a school appropriate theme.
- Event Timeline: We will do our best to stay on time and ask for your patience and understanding that 90% of our staff are all volunteers arriving at the same time you are and this is a FIRST YEAR event. There is much to coordinate in a short time frame. We want to kick his event off as much as you.
 - 0 3:00 - 5:00 Arrival and Check In 5:00 - 5:15 All Ninjas & Masters (Chaperones) to the Starting Pit 0 5:15 – 5:30 All Ninjas & Masters will be directed to their assigned obstacles and courses 0 5:30 - 7:00 Starting Air Horn will kick off the shotgun start on each course, each Squad will compete for 5 0 minutes until the transition horn occurs, and continue until the course in complete. 0 7:00 - 8:00 Top 3 squads in each grade will compete on the Mt. Midoriyama course for the title of Cheyenne Ninja Warrior Champion. The winning Squad will be recognized on Stage to receive their Championship Bibs. All preliminary and championship finishers will receive a Ninja "Finisher" Headband.
 - 8:00 9:00 Enjoy the entertainment, food and evening with friends, teachers and family

- Course Area: Only Ninjas, Masters (Chaperones), Designated Volunteers and Event Staff are allowed on the course areas. This is for the safety of all participating.
- Spectators Trail: We have designated a fenced in area through the course that you CAN travel with food and drink to watch all Ninjas and Masters (Chaperones) compete on their course. This is the only area of travel inside the course field area. Please be respectful of this request.
- > Mt Midoriyama: Upon the Starters Horn this course will be open to all spectators of any age until the championship round.
- Wristbands & T-Shirts: Wristbands and T-shirts will be sent home with your child on Thursday. Every Ninja must arrive with their T-shirt and 2 wristbands already on. \$5 Lost wristband charge.
- Event Keepsake Drone Video: We recommend that teams have fun with colorful legwarmers, tutus, wristbands, socks, etc as there will be drones videoing the event. PREPURCHASE of the video is \$20 and day of \$40
- Racer Fundraising: Kids raise pledges online via Pledgestar or in person. Go to <u>www.pledgestar.com/cheyenne</u> to get started! Prizes based on funds raised include things such as Ninja Necklaces / Dog Tags, Unisex Knee High Socks, gym passes to Scottsdale Parkour and Scottsdale Gymnastics. Ninja course equipment kit (good for all ages), Nintendo Switch or \$350 Apple Gift Card! There will be weekly "races" to see what class can raise the most pledges between February 12 – 16 win a homework pass and February 19 – 23 win a Menchies or Dutch Bros gift card. The student that has raised the most pledges in each grade level as of the day of the race will be recognized on Stage.
