Who are we?


- Non-profit organization that provides educational and recreational support and funding for CTS students and staff



Cheyenne K-5 Math Curriculum Adoption

- Committee member application deadline was October 16th and committee members will be notified of selection by October 24th. 50% of the committee shall be District certified teachers.
- The committee will review, evaluate and recommend quality and appropriate textbooks and instructional resources to replace Saxon Math.
- Committee meetings will be held at Cheyenne in room 104 beginning in November and will run through February.
- Parents will have the opportunity to attend committee meetings and provide feedback.

Principal Remarks

- Open positions update: cafeteria aide, coach and teacher positions have been filled except for the part time middle school gifted position. Admin, along with Mrs. Deak, are working with District to incorporate gifted studies within Humanities classes.
- **Enrollment update:** Currently have 581 families and 905 students. We are 119 students away from being at full capacity.
- School tours begin in November and we have quite a few families signed up.
- District Thanksgiving lunch is back on November 16th! Parents will have the opportunity to join their students for lunch on this day.
